Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. State Law requires proof of Rabies vaccination (a rabies tag) and, for out of state visitors, a health certificate which was signed by your veterinarian within 30 days.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. **Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.**

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of the show at check in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place on soccer turf in a 130' x 80' ring.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS & WARM UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. The walk-through may be split at the judge's discretion.

A warm-up area, consisting of 2 regulation agility jumps, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

PRIZES, AWARDS, & RIBBONS

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each class in each height division. New Title ribbons will be available if requested. MACH, PACH, PAX, and AGCH ribbons and bars will be awarded. All prizes must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

High Scoring Sporting Dog: A special award will be presented in each jump height from the Master/Exc classes. Winning dog in each jump height (Regular and Preferred) must have 2 clean rounds in Saturday's Std & JWW with the fastest combined time from those classes.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating will be allowed in the building, however, exhibitors are encouraged to work from their vehicles. Please use mats underneath all crates. Dogs with space or barking issues should not be crated near the agility ring. Crates may be left overnight; however, GRCI & Canine Sports Zone will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may not be left overnight.

CONCESSIONS

No concessions available; please make your own arrangements. Coolers are allowed and there are various restaurants nearby.

PARKING

There is ample parking at this site. See below for RV parking information.

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Agility Trials run best with plenty of volunteers who give up time with their dogs so you can play with yours. Please consider returning the favor and volunteering. Lunch will be provided to those who volunteer and work at least 3 time slots.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Trial will be held in compliance with COVID-19 state and local public health guidelines. Facility and host club safety rules will be updated on the AgilGold website/ judging schedule. Please be patient and understanding as we work to provide a safe environment for all.

Chapter 5, Section 8, Fix and Go On (FNG)

At any time during a run the handler may immediately fix a single obstacle one time. The action shall be judged as an elimination, which shall be marked as an "E" on the scribe sheet, resulting in a non-qualifying score (NQ). The handler may go back a few obstacles prior to the fix. If a jump bar is knocked, the handler may reset it, but the reset is limited to one jump bar. The dog may not be verbally or physically corrected for the error. Weave poles may be immediately re-attempted three times, but if the dog is brought back to obstacles prior to the weave poles, it will be considered the one-time Fix & Go attempt. Once handlers have used the one-time Fix & Go On option, they must immediately finish the course or exit the ring. The judge shall not judge the dog's run after the fix but will continue to watch the run to ensure that the handler is going on to compete the course correctly, is not using harsh commands or corrections, and that the run is being done safely. The judge will immediately whistle to excuse the team from the ring for any of these infractions.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) in T2B and FAST

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at **the option of the host club**. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s), and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring: Food/treats are NOT.
 - Toys must be non-audible,
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand,
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
 - Lasers, flirt poles, chuck-it balls, toys on long ropes that are being tossed/dragged with the handler holding the end are not permitted.
 - Handlers may not run with their leash & use as a toy.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, AND LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. GRCI and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. GRCI reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against GRCI or any official thereof.

All dogs must be leashed at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. NO flexi-leads allowed indoors. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches that come into season will have their entry refunded less a \$8 per day administrative fee upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

Any dog sustaining an injury after the closing date may have their entry returned, less a \$8 per day administrative fee per day. The owner must provide a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour prior to the start of judging.

WAIT LIST

This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received prior to the closing date. Any entries withdrawn by Monday, June 21, 6 p.m. CST, will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund, or the entry destroyed. If you wish to have your entry returned, you must contact the trial secretary prior to the closing date.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Please keep toys and treats at least 10 feet away from the competition ring.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run and being prompt at the line.

CATALOGS

Advance catalog sales may be ordered and prepaid with your entry form for \$10. Email secretary for details.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
