Verbal changes will not be accepted. All Email move-ups will receive a return confirmation from the trial secretary, who is not responsible for undelivered move-up requests.

Move-ups between Rd 1 and Rd 2 must be given to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of Rd 2.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. *It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running* and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. **VMO's will be at this trial.**

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official Jump Height Card or temporary Jump Height Form at each trial to present upon request.

DNA Number Required

In accordance with the Policy of the Board of Directors of the German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, all German Shorthaired Pointers entering the NSS agility trial must include a DNA number on the entry form unless the GSP has a PAL or ILP number. Entries without a DNA number cannot be accepted and will not be considered a valid entry.

No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Direct inquiries to Kathy Rudolph at agilgold@outlook.com. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned** to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a LEGIBLE e-mail address on the entry form.

Electronic entries will be accepted. Email your completed and signed entry form to the trial secretary. A PayPal invoice will be emailed to you. Once your payment is received, your entry will be processed. A fillable entry form can be found at this link: www.agilgold.com

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

WAIT LIST

This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received prior to the closing date. Any entries withdrawn by Monday, May 6, by 6 p.m. CST, will be replaced by a wait-listed entry, if available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund, or the entry destroyed. If you wish to have your entry returned, you must contact the trial secretary prior to the closing date.

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH.

SPECIAL AWARDS

For each trial, a High in Trial ribbon will be awarded. Trial #2 is considered the NSS Official Trial. HIT for Trial #1 will be calculated the same as for the HIT Note below.

All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial. None will be mailed.

HIT RIBBON

This trophy is awarded annually at the German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America national agility trial. It is awarded to the German Shorthaired Pointer that earns a QQ with perfect scores (100s) from the Regular Excellent or Master Standard and JWW classes and has the highest average yards per second determined by averaging the YPS of the two runs across the Standard and Jumpers classes.

If no QQs are earned from the regular classes, then any QQ earned from the Preferred classes (ties broken similarly by YPS) will be considered. If no QQs are earned in either Regular or Preferred, then if a GSP in Regular qualifies in Excellent/Master in Standard, it will win.

If more than one GSP were to qualify in Standard, the GSP with the highest YPS will be used. If none qualify in Regular Standard, then Excellent/Master Preferred Standard will be used. If none qualify, then Excellent/Master JWW will be used, followed by Excellent/Master Preferred JWW. Similarly, if no Qualifying runs out of Excellent/Master regular or Preferred occur in this progression, then the same progression will be used in Open, and then in Novice.

NOTE: ONLY TRIAL #2 will determine the NSS HIT winner. A HIT for Trial #1 will also be awarded with a HIT Ribbon only.

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Agility Trials run best with plenty of volunteers who give up time with their dogs so you can play with yours. Please consider returning the favor and volunteering. Volunteers will receive water, snacks, and lunch.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. GSPCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against GSPCA or any official thereof. Dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

CRATING/PARKING SPACE: There is some crating space inside, but parking is adjacent to the building for ease in working from your vehicle.

CONCESSIONS: Food/beverages will be available.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Please keep toys and treats at least five feet away from the competition ring. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public-address system, stewards, or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches that come into season will have their entry refunded upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. **Any dog sustaining an injury/illness after the closing date may have their entry returned, less a \$15 per trial administrative fee.** In both cases, the owner must provide the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour prior to the start of judging..

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

What a way to kick off the weekend - join us Saturday, May 11th, for an old-fashioned weenie roast and all-breed Fun Match! A Novice and Excellent level standard course will be nested for you to practice and work whatever skills you'd like.

Entry fee is \$10 for 2 runs. Please send in your dog's name, jump height, and number of runs. If you are entering the trial, you do not have to write a separate check; you can include the fun match entry fees with your entry to the trial.

Day of show entries will be accepted for the fun match only.

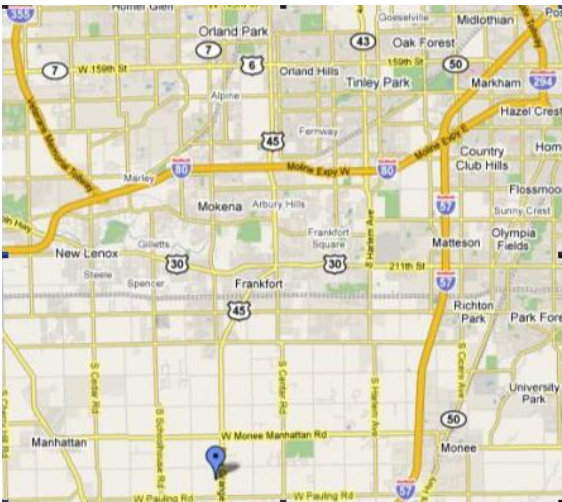
Motor homes and RVs are allowed but there are no hook ups at the trial site. Please contact Kim at lugerandolivia@yahoo.com to reserve a spot.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From I-294 or 94: Exit at I-80 West to I-57 South. Stay on I-57b South for 9.5 miles to the Manhattan-Monee Rd (Rt. 6) exit and go west. Stay on Manhattan-Monee Rd. westbound for 6.5 miles and turn south (left at Rt. 45 (stop sign with flashing light)). Continue 2.5 miles south to the trial site on the west side of Rt. 45. Look for agility trial signs.

I-355 Extension (Veteran's memorial Tollway): The easiest route for those taking the I-355 extension is I-355 south to I-80 East. Exit Route 45 South (about 9 miles) to the trial site.

From the South: Take I-57 North and exit Manhattan-Monee Road. Then follow the directions above.



OBSTACLES, RING CONDITIONS, and LEASHES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on sand/rubber mulch mix in 70' x 115' ring. Contacts are rubberized.

Leashes: Handlers may pocket or wear their leash around their neck or waist while running the course.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARMUP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving the dog.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) is offered in this trial's FAST & T2B classes.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.
